To join the club: You must bring your completed application to a club meeting along with your \$25.00 application fee and \$70.00 annual dues. The secretary will present your application to the membership, and you will be given an opportunity to introduce yourself. At the next meeting your application will be presented to the membership for a vote of acceptance, before which you will have another opportunity to introduce yourself. **You are REQUIRED to attend these two meetings, and the range orientation within the first three months of membership.**

A sponsor will ease your path to membership. If you do not have a sponsor you may complete the range orientation, attend a Saturday night social shoot, or participate in any scheduled event to meet current members.

All applications will go to a membership review committee and will be decided upon individually. Any falsifying of information shall forfeit the application and membership fees. Applicant agrees that if accepted, they will conform to the rules and regulations of the organization, and that they will observe the provisions of the Inland Fish and Game Laws of the State of Maine. **This will be signed yearly upon membership renewal.** By signing the application you consent to a background check and that you will comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations as well as follow all Club and Range Rules.

Once accepted into membership you will take the club Conservation Pledge. For applications which are presented to the membership for the first time in November or December of a calendar year the dues will be paid through to the following calendar year. Any application presented to membership from January through October will pay full membership dues for that calendar year and then will owe dues on a yearly basis beginning the following January. Dues will be determined yearly, after budget meeting is conducted in December. Annual Dues are due every January with new signed application.

NEW members must attend a MANDATORY range/club orientation before they receive their access pin for the ranges. Contact the Chief Instructor to take your orientation. Please visit the club webpage documents section to view/print the club By-Laws, Range Rules, and other important information. Also, if you have a quest with you it is mandatory to fill out liability form.
